SOS serves families and individuals during times of financial difficulties with food, assistance with payment of mortgage, rent, utilities, transportation, clothing, household items, holiday giving, summer snack sacks for students & job assistance services - **15,636 times last year!**

Receptionists: If you are a friendly, caring person, you are needed at the reception desk to assist our clients who walk in the front door in completing the documentation to receive food and/or emergency basic needs services and take incoming phone calls.

Client Services Counselors meet with neighbors who need emergency assistance to pay their rent or mortgage to prevent eviction, utilities or life sustaining medications and determine if any assistance can be provided for them.

Data Input Clerks - You will input confidential data regarding our clients in our tracking system and file the documents.

Job Assistance Mentors - Assist job seekers with on-line applications, resume updates, job coaching, job readiness workshop assistance

Prayer Partners - One-on-one private time with our clients in need of prayer and hope.

Finance & Budget Mentors - Discuss our simple method of budgeting and allocation of disposable income with clients.

Pantry Helpers: Unload food donations, organize & stock the pantry and assist clients in selecting food.

Truck Unloaders: Unload the trucks from Montgomery County Food Bank on Monday and stock the groceries and produce.

SOS RESALE SHOP

Our Resale Shop offers the donations we receive such as clothing, shoes, pictures, home furnishings and furniture. Proceeds from the shop are donated to the general ministry of SOS to purchase food for the Food Pantry or to provide emergency financial assistance to our clients.

Incoming Clothing and Donations: Receive the donated items and clothing, sort, price, size, hang and stock clothing, shoes and household furnishings.

Delivery Drivers: Using your own pick-up truck, your help is needed one day each week for a few hours to "make the rounds" and pick up donated items from the Resale Shop and take them to The Giving Center a few blocks away. Also, you may be needed to pick up donated items from people's homes and/or deliver furniture purchases to their home.
